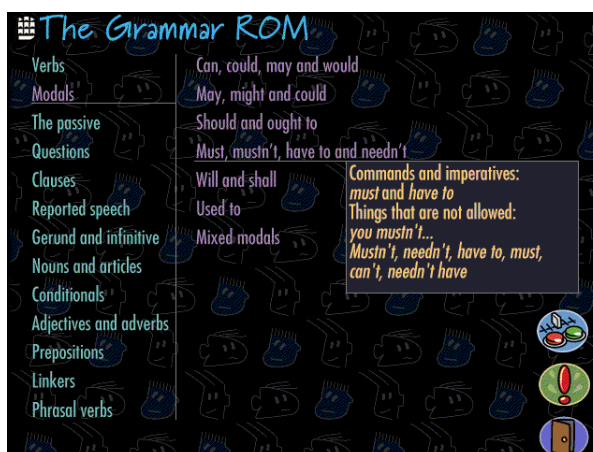
screen explanation.
