### Business Territory 1

*Business Territory 1* is a learning resource built around a collection of video interviews recorded in a Cambridge company. It exposes students to authentic, idiomatic business English. The non-scripted language of the interviews offers a variety of British accents and prepares learners for communication in real-life business environments. The integrated activities cover around 40 hours of student work and the language auditing task-types include true / false comprehension, opinion-gap, ranking, gapfill, and language auditing. These activities encourage students to watch the interviews from a variety of perspectives and use their language for communicative purposes.

### Business Territory 2

This takes you on a guided tour behind the scenes at the University Arms in Cambridge. Students have access to short video interviews with real members of staff - all the interviews are entirely authentic and unscripted. For anyone learning about the Hotel and Catering business this is a new and ideal way to improve your English.

### Expert Gallery

Each *Expert Gallery* title focuses on a particular area of professional expertise. The first in the series is based on a consultation session with an experienced accountant explaining how to go about setting up a company and managing its finances. The content is authentic both in the sense that it is an expert answering questions without a script and because his answers are the same as he usually gives to his clients.

### Opinion Zone 1

*Opinion Zone* deals with the language of expressing opinions. Each title is built around a studio debate. Topics vary from banning handguns to the power of the press. In addition to the studio material, *Opinion Zone* titles will include a variety of interviews with people ranging from an Australian government minister to a street vendor. *Opinion Zone* titles are not intended to be self-contained courses; rather, they are classroom resources that teachers can call on to support an existing study programme.

Many students return from trips to the UK or the US saying that they came across people they simply couldn't understand at all. So, what can be done about this? How can students be prepared for real-world communication in English? These forty-eight interviews in *Vox pop* offer the student a wide range of accents, topics and native speaker authentic language.
